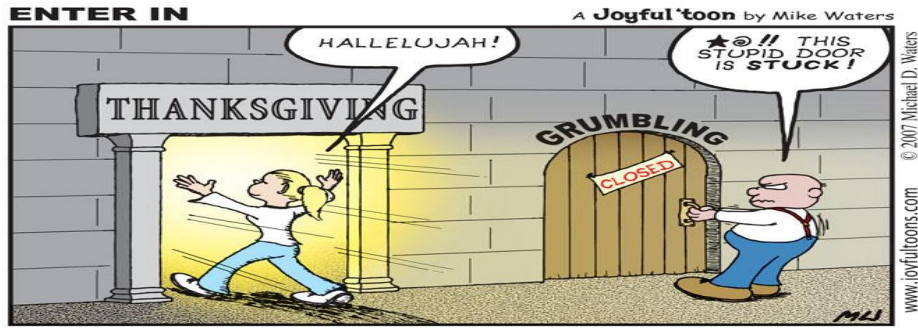




Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. — PSALM 100:4 NIV
