


**LOVE LETTER**

You are My friends if you do whatever I command you."* John 15: 11-13. How sweet it is when God's children are obedient to display His love to others! God's desire is that we bear much fruit. In order to bear good fruit, we must be grounded in His word; His truth. John 15:1-4; *"I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit, He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me."* How great a gift is it that they are teaching their children to love one another? When we give ourselves from a complete place of love, the fruit it bears is eternal. Last week, we shared about conditional and unconditional love. Do all things as unto the Lord in love and not for attention from man. Jesus goes on to teach in John 15:5; *"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing."* Verse 8 goes on to say, *"By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so, you will be My disciples."* Did you recognize the fruit when Olive shared the burning bush with us last Sunday? Oh Lord, let us all bear Your fruit!
