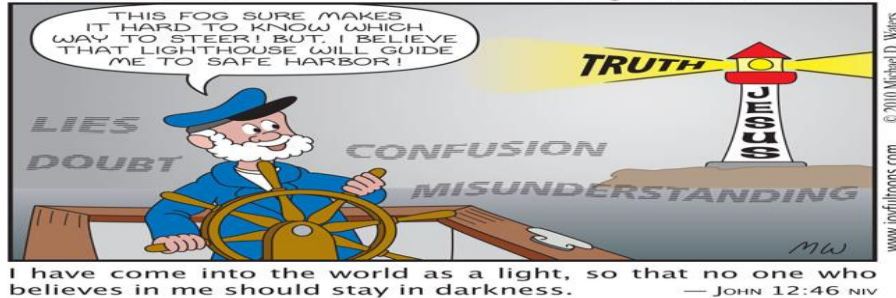


LIGHTHOUSE
